Open Field Winter Training Trials

Last Sunday of the month November – March

Nov 29 (double lift)

Dec 27 (fetch & drive daze)

Jan 31 (double lift)

Feb 28 (fetch & drive daze)

March 28 (double lift)

We will vary between running on the ewe flock or the lambs. If weather permits we will try to change fields. In all classes you can leave the post to help your dog and may stay on the field for your allotted time. See course descriptions below.

Open & pro-novice \$25 per run

Ranch & novice \$20 per run

No limit on number of runs per dog.

\$5 of each entry fee will go to Inland Northwest & Ravensgate rescues.

Reserve run times by email in the following time blocks: 9-11, 11-1, 1-3. Please tell me your best time and an alternate. Reserved times get priority on the field but drop-ins are welcome.

We will have the grill running and will furnish hot dogs and chili with fixings. Bring side dishes to share if you wish.

Double lift day courses

Open and pro-novice will run the same course – 300 yard gathers

Pro-novice handlers will bring first gather to their feet and may move to other side of sheep to send dog on lookback and, if they wish, will do a standard shed of any three on the head. Open dogs will have a drop zone for the first gather and do an international shed followed by pen.

Ranch & Novice dogs will gather 100-150 yards, turn post, fetch or assisted drive the open drive triangle, pen. While sheep are still in the pen they will do a second gather.

Fetch & Drive daze courses

Open dogs will have a double dog leg fetch and a three gate drive, followed by shed, pen, single.

Pro-novice dogs can choose a standard fetch or a single dog leg, standard drive, pen, shed.

Ranch & novice will have a standard gather with panels, turn post, fetch or drive the full triangle, pen. While sheep are still in the pen they will do a second gather.

At any of these training trials if you feel your dog needs a more straight forward course please feel free to run your course to suit your training needs.
